For Lector(s): Lector #1 will be the Lector for the Mass celebrated in the Church, and will also serve as a back-up EMHC, if needed, to fill in in the event of assigned EMHC absence or if no priest or deacon assisting the celebrant.

Lector #2, if designated, will be the Lector for the overflow Mass celebrated in the Community Center. If no Cantor is present in the Community Center, Lector #2 is also responsible for reading the Responsorial Psalm in between the First and Second Readings. If no priest or deacon is assisting the celebrant at the Community Center Mass, Lector #2 will also serve as an EMHC to assist the celebrant in the distribution of Holy Communion.

For EMHCs: The assigned EMHC is responsible for communicating the Cantor, the Lector and the altar servers on the south (pulpit/ambo) side of the Sanctuary and then for staffing the Baptismal font distribution position on the north (Mary altar) side of the Church.
