**For Lectors:** Lector #1 will be the Lector for the Mass celebrated in the Church, and will also serve as a back-up EMHC, if needed.

Lector #2, will be the Lector for the overflow Mass celebrated in the Community Center, and will assist the celebrant in the distribution of Holy Communion.

**For EMHCs:** The assigned EMHC is responsible for communicating the Cantor, the Lector and the altar servers on the south (pulpit/ambo) side of the Sanctuary and then for staffing the Baptismal font distribution position on the north (Mary altar) side of the Church.

**For 9:30 am Lectors:** The “Scrutinies” will be celebrated only at the 9:30 a.m. Masses in the Church on March 7<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup>. **Lectors at those Masses only** should read the alternative YEAR A readings at those Masses, beginning on pp 84, 94 and 103, respectively, of the Lector Workbook. **At all other Masses, including the 9:30 a.m. Community Center Masses, the regular YEAR B readings should be read.**

**For Palm Sunday Lectors:** Lectors will participate in the four-part reading of the Passion, each reading the part indicated in the Schedule, with **N** being the Narrator (or Reader), **C** being the Crowd, and (in the Community Center only) **V** being the Voice. Detailed instructions to follow.
