ALTAR SOCIETY ACTIVITIES 2021-2022

Altar Society Committees & Events:

- **Angel Tree** – Volunteer to assist parishioners in selecting their angel or returning their gifts for the needy during this long-standing Christ the King tradition each December
- **Addressing Team** - Join other team members to prepare mailings to the Altar Society.
- **Fundraising** – Assist with our annual fundraising event with proceeds supporting the Altar Society and possibly an additional charity.
- **Christmas & Spring Membership Teas** – Help as needed for set up and to greet guests.
- **Ad Hoc Helpers** – Assist committee chair with planning, setting up, or greeting members at various Altar Society or parish events including Altar Society meetings or events, parish receptions or donut Sundays.

Spiritual Programs:

- **First Friday Eucharist Adoration** – Sign up for a specific hour, or to receive email reminders.
- **Advent & Lent Mornings of Reflections** – Assist Chair with decorating and set-up for the retreats, as well as help with serving the food.
- **Daily Rosary** – Join the church community in praying the daily Rosary. Various times are listed in the church bulletin and all are always welcome.
- **Prayer Chain** – Join the prayer chain or make a prayer request by contacting the number listed in the church bulletin.

Parish Services:

- **Altar Care** - Clean the Altar and Sacristy, maintain the Altar flowers, and clean the Altar linens and priestly garments. Every Monday and Thursday after the 8:00 am Mass.
- **Funeral Reception Assistance** – Provide assistance to families who have experienced a death, by helping to set up, work, or clean -up at a catered funeral reception at the church
- **Visits to Parishioners** – Visit Christ the King parishioners at their homes, in nursing homes or assisted living homes. (Must be current with your Diocesan Safe Environment Training.)
- **Welcome New Parishioners** – Help with the set up and or work the January Welcome Reception.
- **Parish Community Weekend** – Help set-up refreshments and coffee and greet parishioners after the Sunday masses on the annual September Parish Community Weekend

Community Outreach:

- **Meals on Wheels** – Deliver meals to those who are homebound.
- **North Dallas Shared Ministries** – Help the needy through this organization that unites the efforts of 52 North Dallas religious communities.
- **Our Lady of Perpetual Help School** – Help with various needs at this local Catholic school where the majority of students live below the poverty line.
- **St. Joseph's Residence** – Spread joy by visiting residents of this Catholic Retirement Community.
