Today we celebrate the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ, who paid the penalty for our sin and made eternal life a reality for all of the faithful. The parallels between the Passover Lamb of the Old Testament, and the Lamb of God reaffirm the connections between the testaments as one revelation of God. The Passover Lamb was an unblemished male, and the blood from the lamb was applied to the doorways of the Israelites in order to protect them from the Angel of Death. Similarly, the shed blood of Christ paid the penalty of sin and preserves the lives of the faithful. It is not by the death of our Lord that we obtain eternal life, but in His resurrection from the dead and His ascension into glory, where He is seated at the right hand of the Father, who prepares a place for us in heaven.
